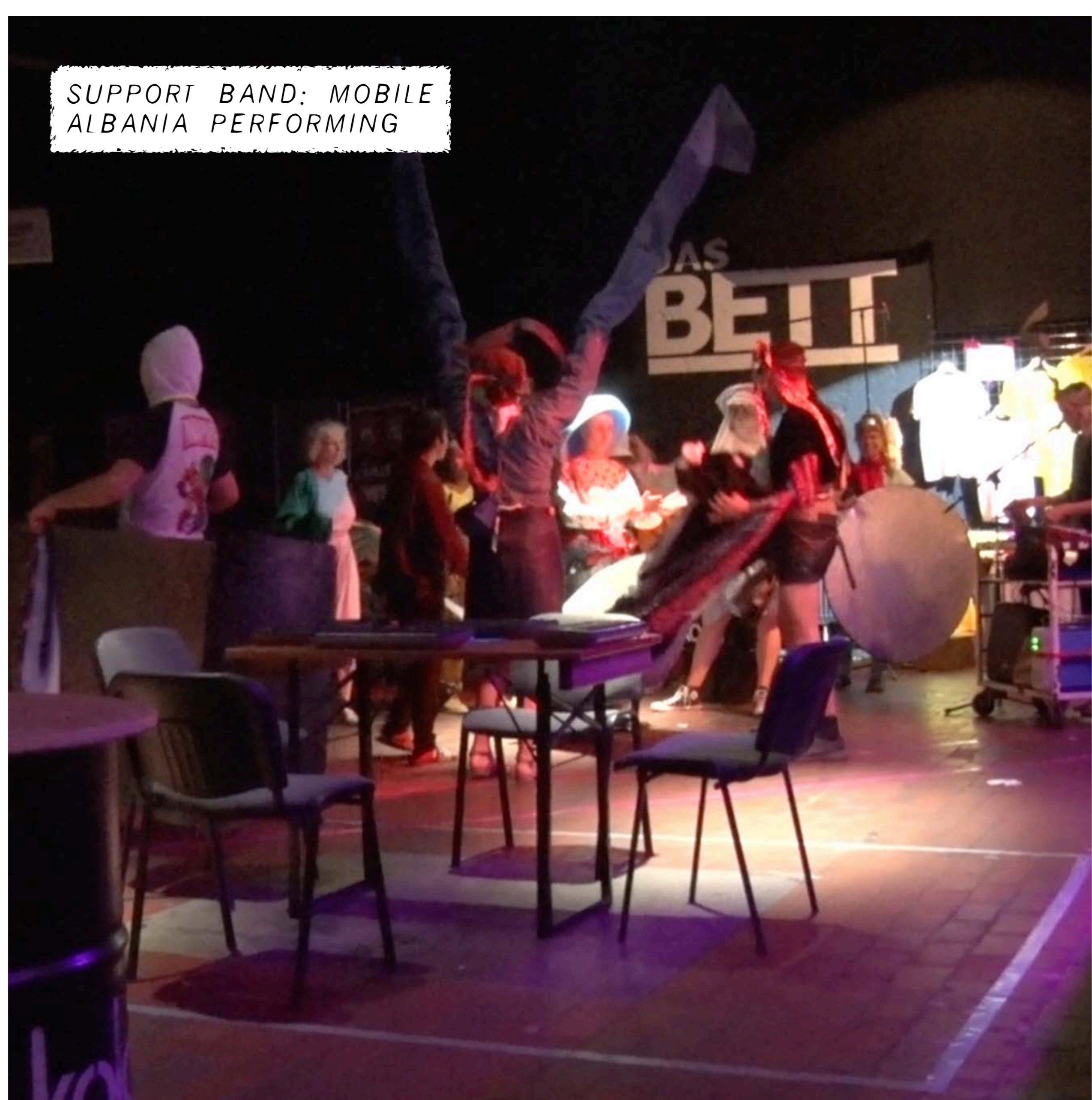
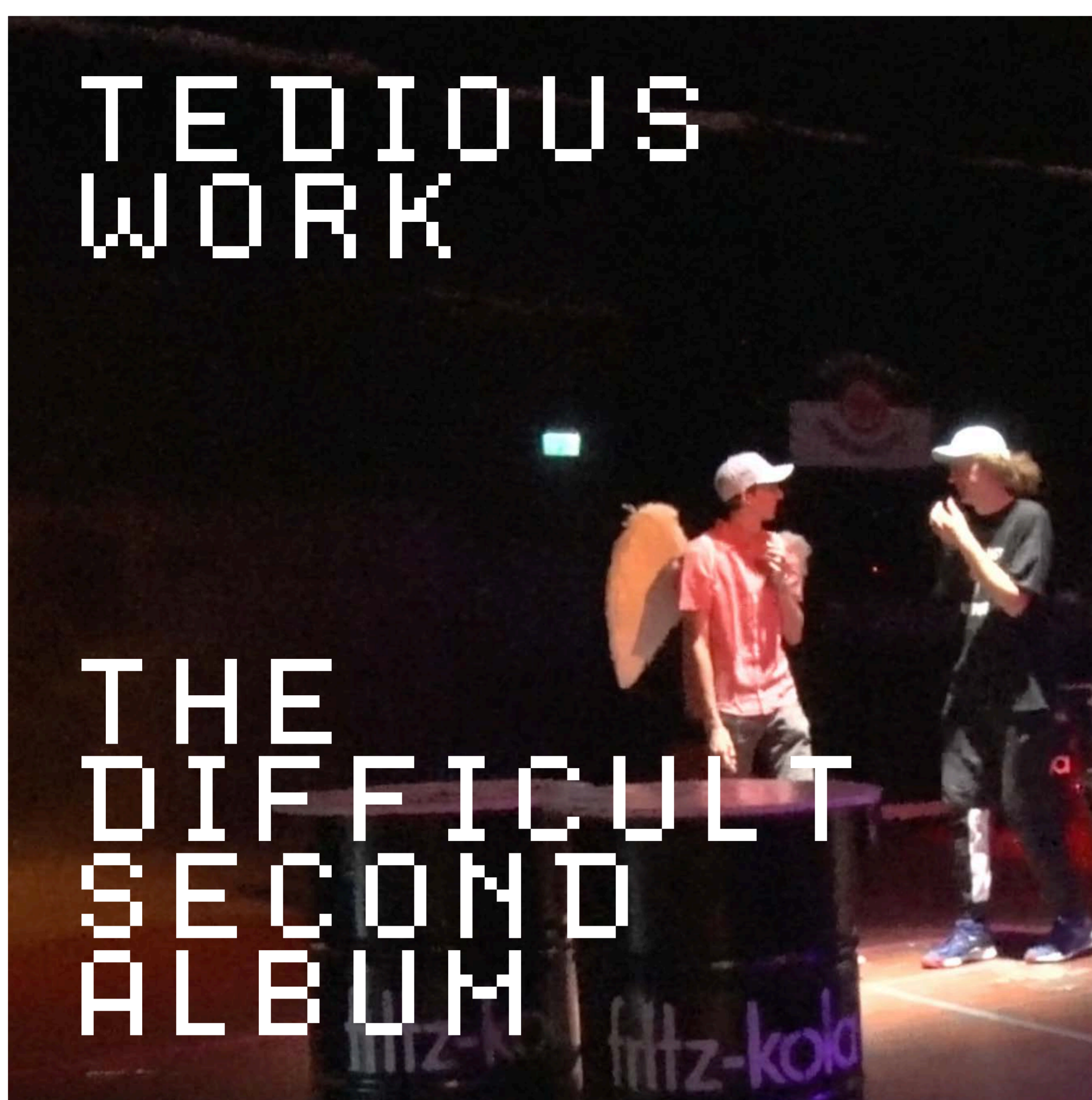

"Paul, do you know a song by the Dresden dolls?"

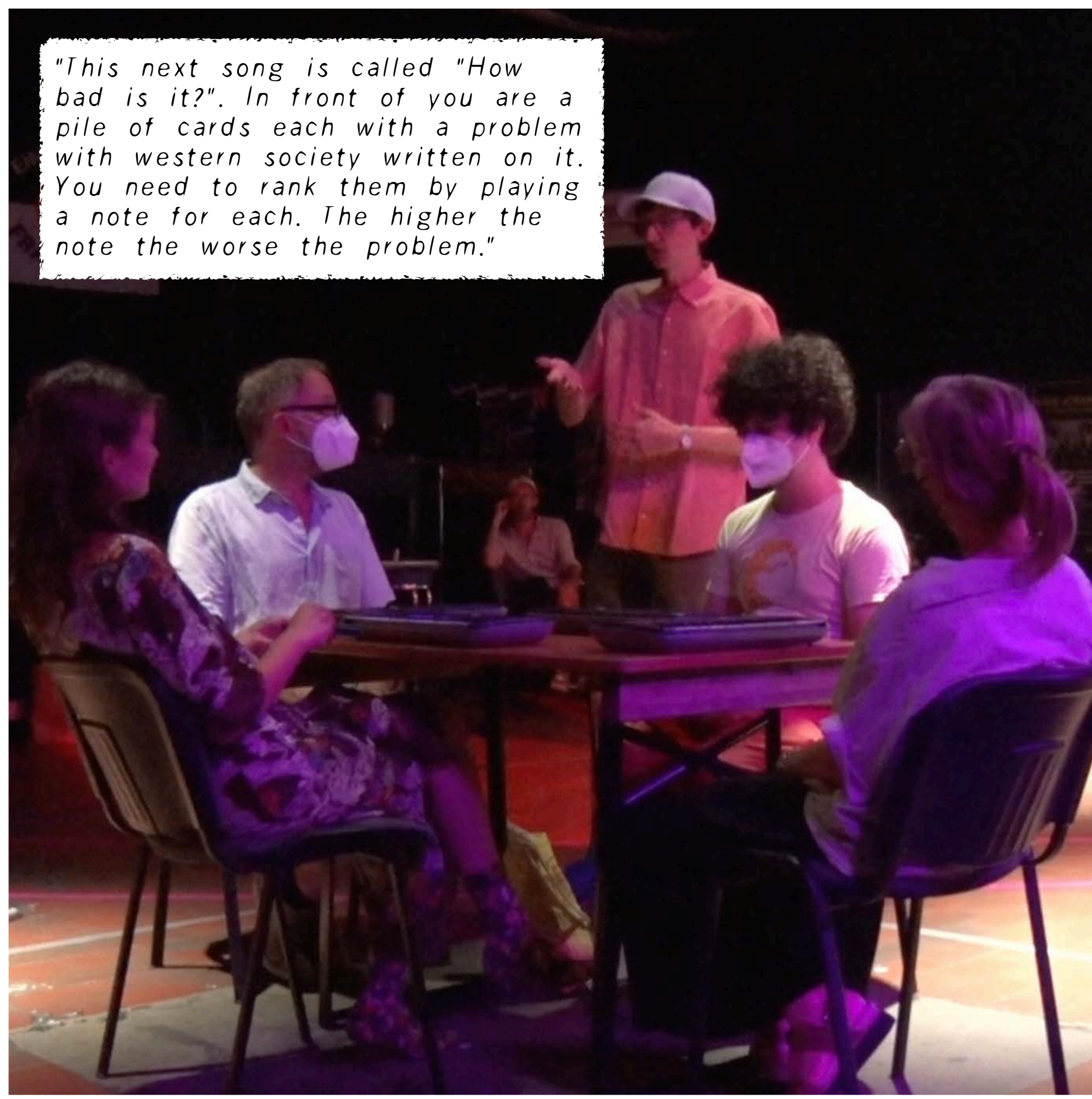
"No."

"Roll all the dice on the table, then looking at the numbers and colours set yourself an organisational goal. You may trade dice with others but only ever one die for one die"



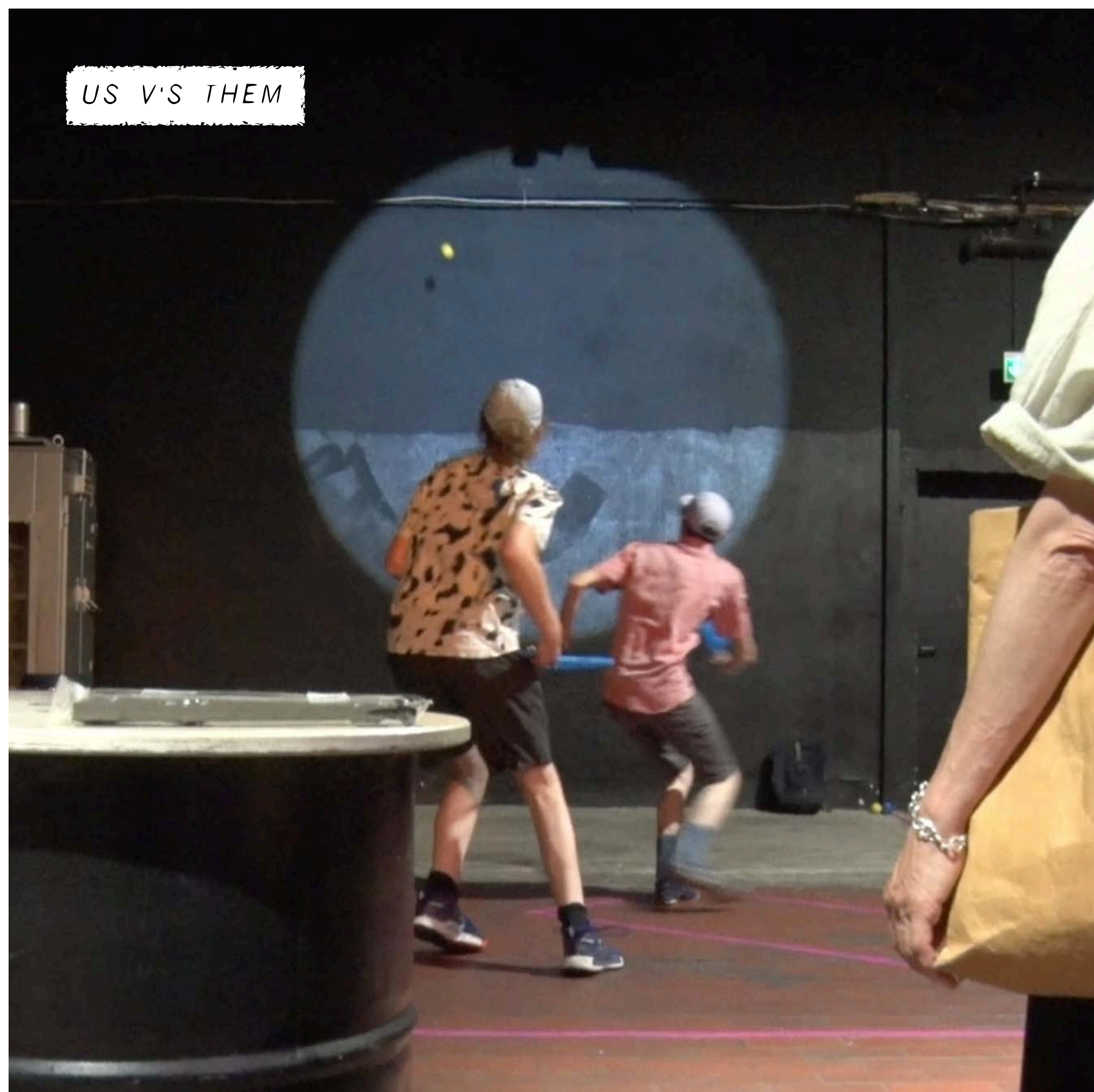

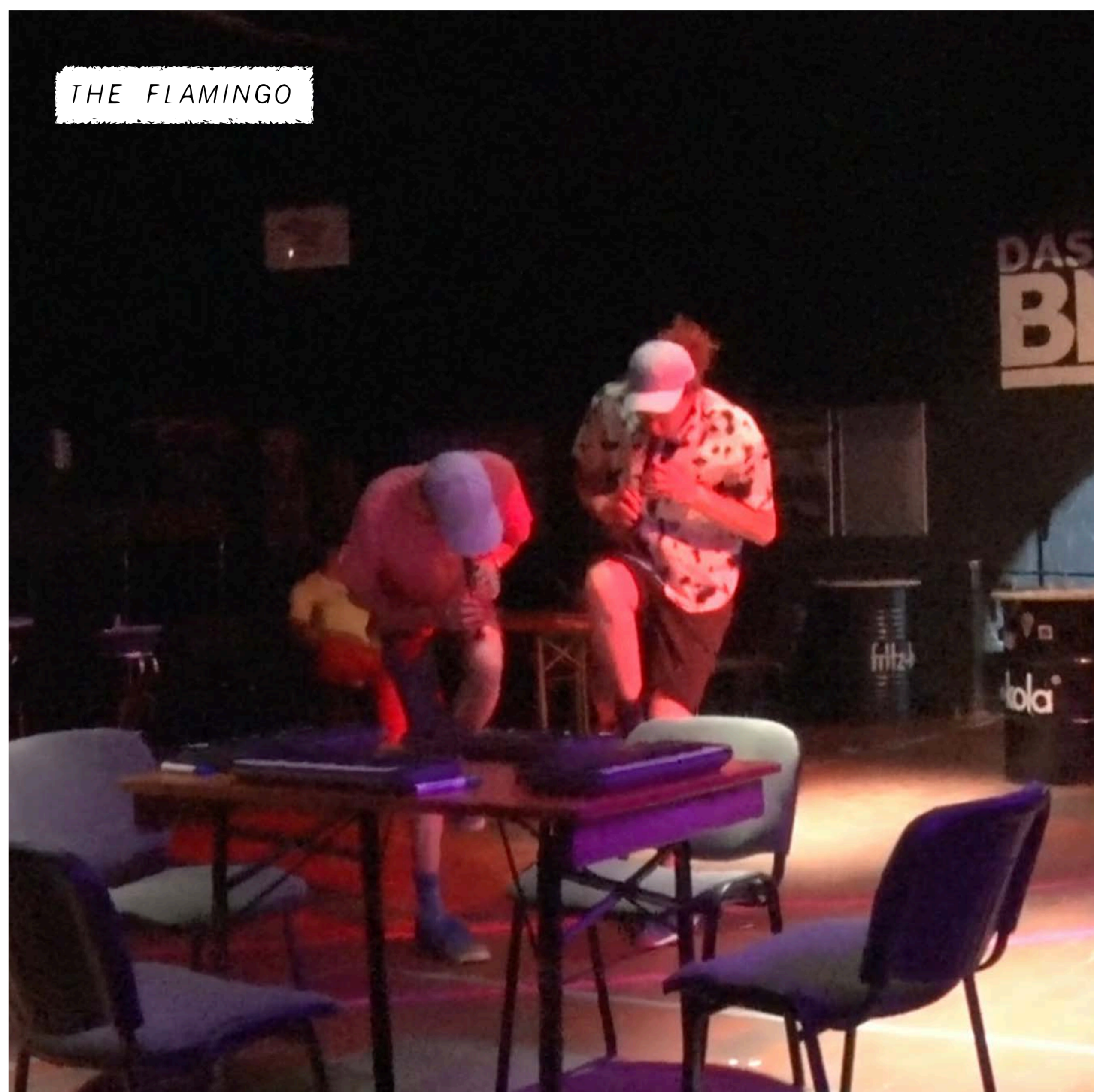
